SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

THE RAMSGATE SPRINT REVIVAL will be held on Saturday the 14th August and Sunday 15th August 2015, commencing at 12.00 hrs on Saturday and Sunday. The event will be organised by the Invicta Motor Cycle Club (Ramsgate).

- 3. COURSE.** The course is on the A299 Royal Harbour Approach, Ramsgate and is 180 yards long. It runs in a westerly direction from close to the old café and steps situated approximately 110 yards from the Port Ramsgate entrance roundabout. The road is 24 feet wide for the first 50 yards before opening out to 32 feet wide. The course is straight and level with a good tarmac surface. After the finish line the road curves very slightly to the right and continues to be 32 feet wide for a further 220 yards when it reduces in width to 24 feet. At this point there is a raised "Keep Left" island in the centre of the road which temporarily reduces the road to two lanes of 9 feet wide. From this point the road continues at 24 feet wide for another 170 yards on a tightening but still slow bend to a slip road accessing the assembly area. Royal Harbour Approach continues beyond this slip road for another 1400 yards via a tunnel. Access to this tunnel is prohibited for any reason other than an emergency. Riders are prohibited from accelerating after crossing the finish line and must obey all signs and signals to slow down. Any rider not complying with these instructions may be disqualified at the sole discretion of the Clerk of the Course. After completing their runs, all riders and their machines must assemble as instructed by the marshals & return along the course when instructed to do so.
- 4. JURISDICTION.** The meeting will be held under the National Sporting Code and Standing Regulations of the ACU, these Supplementary Regulations and any Final Instructions issued or Official Announcements made. Standing regulations for sprinting are available from the ACU on 01788-566400. The Demonstration event will be held under a restricted permit.
- 5. RIDER ELIGIBILITY.** This event is open to riders with a competition licence issued by the ACU and the SACU. Riders must be 18 yrs of age and over. Invicta MCC two day membership and ACU One Event competition licences can be obtained from the Secretary of the meeting prior to demonstrating. Please note that ACU One Event competition licences are available to UK Residents only.
- 6. MACHINE ELIGIBILITY.** Machines taking part in this event must be of a type from the production period pre 1972 and must be normally aspirated. The main aim is to try and present machines which look and function as they would have done in sprints of the period they represent. Only one rider per machine will be permitted. Eligibility will be at the sole discretion of the organisers.
- 7. ENTRY FEES.** All entries must be made on the official entry form and sent to the Secretary of the Meeting by Friday 4th July 2015, with the appropriate fee which is £25.00 per rider for one day, £35 for both days, plus if required ACU One Event Competition Licence £10.00, Invicta MCC Two Day Membership £3.00, and 2 self addressed envelopes – minimum size C5. Please make cheques payable to "Invicta MCC". The club reserves the right to refuse entry, abandon, cancel or postpone the meeting or alter the programme of events. Telephone entries will not be accepted under any circumstances. Entry fees will be refundable at the discretion of the Invicta MCC (Ramsgate). All entrants are requested to provide a colour photograph of their motorcycle with their entry form. The print should be at least postcard size.
- 8. INSURANCE.** The Club undertakes to insure each driver and passenger, indemnifying him/her against third party claims made arising out of the Demonstration event, excluding claims by other drivers or passengers, entrant, sponsor or mechanic.

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

9. **TECHNICAL VERIFICATION.** Riders are to present themselves with their machines at technical verification, fully clothed in leathers, helmet etc. as for demonstrating. All old technical verification stickers must be removed. It is the responsibility of the rider to ensure a machine and equipment used in demonstration is mechanically and structurally in a safe condition and fit for the intended purpose (ACU National Sporting Code, appendix B). Road legal "Standard" machines must ensure all lights and lenses are taped. (head, tail & brake etc). All prop/centre or other stands must be removed or retained in the up position by means of fixed fastening prior to practice or racing.
10. **HELMETS.** Helmets bearing the current ACU gold stamp and in sound condition and properly fitted must be worn by all riders and passengers whenever a machine is being ridden. A visor or goggles must be used when practicing or racing
11. **FUEL.** Fuel is restricted to types used in the period up to 1972. Machines running on fuel containing any amount of nitro-methane are not permitted to enter.
12. **FUEL TAPS.** All machines must have an easily accessible fuel shut off tap with the ON/OFF positions clearly marked..
13. **OIL.** The rider of a machine dumping excessive oil will be disqualified.
14. **STARTING OF MACHINES.** The organisers do not undertake to provide any mechanical starting apparatus or assistance.
15. **SOUND CONTROL.** The Clerk of the Course may disqualify any machine which in his opinion is deemed to be excessively noisy. Sound must be kept to a minimum in the paddock and when returning after each run.
16. **CLASSES.** Machines may be grouped into classes for identification purposes only. Number plates must be fitted. One facing forward and vertical and one either side of the machine. The number must be that allocated by the Secretary of the Meeting and must comply with colours specified in SR 8.14. The riding number will be advised upon acceptance of entry. All machines must comply with ACU standing sprint regulations in their entirety. NB: Following acceptance of your entry, changes to rider or machine will only be permitted with the prior written consent of the Secretary of the Meeting.
17. **LIMITATIONS OF ENTRY.** The organiser's reserve the right to limit entries in any class and/or the acceptance of an entry; the aim being to represent a range of machines as per the historic events between 1956 - 1968.
18. **PROGRAMME.** Riders should present themselves for demonstration runs as instructed by the organiser's. Riders will be afforded a minimum of two runs. Timings may vary at the discretion of the organisers and subject to notice being given to riders.
 - 10:00 hrs: Signing on & Technical Verification
 - 11:15 hrs: Riders briefing
 - 12:00 hrs: Demonstration runs commence
 - 16:00 hrs: Demonstration runs end
19. **CONDUCT.** Any rider who fails to comply with instructions or is considered to be riding or behaving in a reckless or dangerous manner, or in a manner liable to cause a nuisance anywhere on the site of an event will be penalised by the Clerk of the Course. Riders are responsible for the behaviour of all persons associated with them at an event. Wheelies, burnouts and excessive speed in non-racing areas are prohibited; offenders will be disqualified from the meeting.
20. **AWARDS.** This is a DEMONSTRATION event; there will be no awards.

ENTRY DECLARATION: I the undersigned apply to enter the event described above and in consideration thereof: -

- I consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU.
- I confirm that the machine(s) as described below which I shall participate on shall be suitable and proper for the purpose. I confirm that I am eligible to participate on the machines for which I have entered.
- I confirm that if any part of the event takes place on a public highway, the machine(s) described below shall be insured as required by the Road Traffic Acts, or equivalent legislation, and that they will comply with the regulations in respect thereof.
- I accept responsibility for any items borrowed from the Organiser during the course of the event. These items include but are not restricted to (safety clothing, transponders, accessories). I understand that I am liable for the cost or replacement of any items lost or not returned and non-payment or non-replacement of items borrowed may affect my entry into subsequent events.
- I confirm that I have not been refused an ACU Licence, nor had an ACU Licence suspended, nor have I been excluded from any ACU competition.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE RISKS OF MOTORSPORT: I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, any event organiser, any circuit owner, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

I have read the above and acknowledge that my participation in motorsport is entirely at my own risk. I agree that I am required to register on arrival by "signing on" at the designated place before taking part in any Practice Session or Race.
